to get the word out. The sign up will be extended until the end of January. NASP will give you a scholarship for college every year.

- STAR assessments are held from now until the end of the month for all grades, math and reading. 4th graders made goals this year so they own the score, and they can improve their own score. • In December we were state inspected. I am happy to announce that our certificate of compliance has been renewed for another year. We had a few violations that I quickly addressed and the only violation that incurred a cost was the need to purchase 4 new trash cans with lids. Anyone interested in looking at our violations along with the plan of corrections can stop by the modular, they are posted there. In addition, the total capacity decreased by 41 children since losing the classroom in the building.

Fundraisers –

- Second chance goods totaled \$785in sales and the profit was \$243.
- Twisted Twins Salsa begins today and will end 1/24. All orders will be delivered by 2/5 or 2/6 just in time for the Superbowl parties. If you are interested in purchasing salsa, please reach out to any Be Safe preschool or after school family.
- With the profits from our Krispy Kreme fundraiser and the second Chance fundraiser (and the salsa), we will be purchasing the much-needed walkie talkies.
 The final cost is \$2688.
